6. **Job Description** : i) *An Assistant Professor's job involves teaching under graduates and graduates, designing and developing curricula, & conducting research to contribute to the field through publications and presentations. Other duties include mentoring students, participating in departmental service,*

and staying current in their academic field to advance their own professional development & the institution's goals.

ii) A Workshop Superintendent oversees daily workshop operations, managing staff, equipment, and resources to ensure productivity and quality standards are met. Key responsibilities include supervising technicians, maintaining machinery, enforcing safety protocols, managing inventory, and potentially serving as a liaison for clients. The role requires a blend of strong leadership, technical expertise, and organizational skills to ensure smooth, efficient, and safe operations within the workshop

7. Education Qualification:

i) Civil Engineering & Electronics & Workshop Superintendent :

B.E./B.Tech./B.S. and M.E./M.Tech./M.S. or integrated M.Tech. in relevant branch with first class or equivalent in any one of the degrees.

ii) Management :

Bachelor's Degree in any discipline and Master's Degree in Business Administration/PGDM/C.A./ICWA/M.Com. with First Class or equivalent and two years of Professional experience after acquiring the degree of Master's degree.

iii) Computer Engineering :

B.E./B.Tech./B.S. and M.E./M.Tech./M.S. or Integrated M.Tech. in relevant in relevant branch with First Class or equivalent in any one of the degrees.

Or

B.E., B.Tech. and MCA with First Class or equivalent in any one of the two degrees.

Or

Graduation of three years' duration with Mathematics as a compulsory subject and MCA with First Class or equivalent with 2 years of relevant experience after acquiring degree of MCA.

iv) For Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics & English Eligibility (A or B):

A.

- i) Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university. A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC)(Non-creamy Layer)/Differently-abled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid

attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst person under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5 % to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.

- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET :

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinance/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voice of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

NOTE: NET/SLET/SET shall also not to be required for such Master Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

OR

B. The Ph.D degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World university Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai)

Documentary support to proof fulfillment of all eligibility conditions should not be dated later than the last date of application, and the same should be uploaded latest by the last date of application.

8. Disqualification :

- i) Canvassing (**insawipui**) by a candidate directly or indirectly will disqualify the candidate.
- ii) Any candidate who, on verification at any stage of the recruitment process, does not fulfil any of the eligibility conditions, will be disqualified.

9. Government servants will have to apply through proper channel.

Certified photocopies of Certificate and Marksheet of all academic record from HSLC and above and Caste/Tribal/OBC Certificate (for SC/ST/OBC only) should be submitted along with the application form.
